Private insurance Long Term Disability (LTD) claim appeals, and the Disability Tax Credit (DTC).

The creation of the company in 2004 was a direct result of her personal experience with disability issues, which she encountered when her daughter was born with Spina Bifida. Susana's experience is vast when it comes to government relations: a former Special Assistant to the President of the Treasury Board of the federal government of Canada under the administration of Prime Minsters' the Honorable Jean Chretien and the Honorable Paul Martin, she has expertise in navigating government bureaucracy and interpreting legislation.
